



OAA CENTENNIALS SERVICE AWARD 2007 - 2010

In celebration of the World Scouting Centennial (2007), the OAA's 20th Anniversary (2009), and the BSA's Centennial Anniversary (2010) every member is encouraged to seek a further involvement in Scouting, as time and talents allow, by earning this limited time only "OAA Centennials Service Award."

Members have until December 31st, 2010 to complete the requirements, which are designed to help your local district, council and lodge. Upon completion of the Centennials Award you will receive a pocket patch, card and certificate suitable for framing. Extra patches may also be purchased. Patch is suitable for wear with the Scout uniform.

When you complete the requirements please send this form to the OAA and allow two to three weeks for processing. Recipients will be listed in issues of the Deep Water Traveler.

1. Earn the OAA Service Award or the Turtle Award.
2. Do any 10 of the following (some requirements may be the same as in the OAA Service Award and Turtle Award. If so you may count them as being completed for this award):
 - a. Participate in your council's or lodge's Scouting centennial event, as scheduled.
 - b. Participate in a Camp Promotions presentation.
 - c. Attend a Council or Lodge work weekend in support of your summer camp.
 - d. Serve as Chair of a District, Council, or Lodge activity.
 - e. Serve on the Committee of a District, Council, or Lodge activity.
 - f. Attend a National High Adventure Base, such as Philmont, Florida Sea Base, etc.
 - g. Help conduct a Friends of Scouting / Sustaining Membership Enrollment presentation on a Unit, District or Council Level.
 - h. Help conduct a Junior Leader Training Course in your Council.
 - i. Conduct a service project in the name of the OAA (either through your OAA Chapter, or yourself representing the OAA).
 - j. Attend the 2009 NOAC.
 - k. Attend the 2010 BSA Scout Jamboree.
 - l. Recruit three new members into the OAA and have earned the Silver Bullion OAA Flap.
 - m. Submit a patch design for a future issue of an OAA flap or event patch.
 - n. Submit an article for the Deep Water Traveler.
 - o. Serve as an adult advisor to a Scout working towards his Eagle Scout Badge.
 - p. Are already, or become, a James West Fellow.
